APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2022-34

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Craighead County, Arkansas, an Ordinance to be entitled.

An **ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE RATES OF TAXATION** to be levied against personal and real property in Craighead County for the use and benefit of the cities, towns, schools, and other entities in Craighead County for the tax year of 2022 to be collected in 2023.

ARTICLE 1. The tax rate to be levied on all taxable personal and real property in Craighead County for the use and benefit of the various cities, towns, schools, and other entities in Craighead County, Arkansas, for the tax year of 2022 to be collected in the year 2023 shall be as follows:





RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 22:192 BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS TO LEVY A 1 MILL TAX ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR THE PUBLIC LIBRARY PURSUANT TO THE VOTE OF THE CITIZENS

WHEREAS, Resolution 22:192 was approved on October 18, 2022 approving the millage of 2 mills on the dollar for the support, operation, and maintenance of the public library; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of Amendment 30 of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, a duly qualified election was held on November 8, 2022 upon presentation of a petition by voters; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the electors voted in favor of a reduction of the millage for the public library, and approved an annual levy on all real and personal property within the City for the support, operation, and maintenance of the public library, specifying a rate of taxation of 1 mill on the dollar; and

WHEREAS, these questions being answered by a majority of the qualified voters the Mayor proclaimed it adopted by law.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: Resolution 22:192 is hereby amended.

SECTION 2: Pursuant to the millage rollback computation - Arkansas Statute 84-493.2; Section 3, Act 848, the taxation will be as follows: On all real property the taxes are at the rate of 1 mill on the dollar and on all personal property, excepting household goods, the rate is 1 mill on the dollar.

RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS TO LEVY A ONE-HALF (.5) MILL TAX ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR THE LOCAL POLICE PENSION AND RELIEF FUND

WHEREAS, a duly qualified election was held in accordance with A.C.A. 24-11-404 to provide for a tax levy not to exceed one (1) mill on the dollar upon the assessed value of the real and personal property contained in the city, for the purpose of funding a local pension and relief fund for police officers and their survivors; and

WHEREAS, a majority of those voting approved the levy to fund the local pension fund; and

WHEREAS, the above law requires an annual levy be made by the City council, and certified to the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that in order to raise said sum, it is necessary to levy a tax of one-half (.5) mill on the dollar on all real property and one-half (.5) mill on the dollar on all personal property, excepting household goods; and

WHEREAS, the city has consolidated administration of its Local Police Pension and Relief Fund with the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to extend said tax upon the tax book and that the same be collected in the same manner as other property taxes are collected.

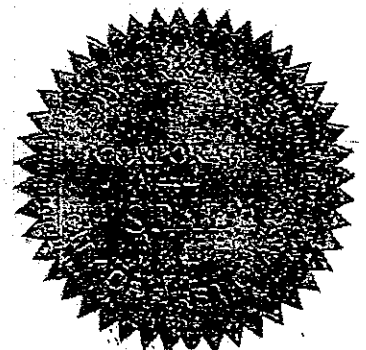

The amount certified shall then be placed upon the tax books of the County Clerk of the County and collected in the same manner that State and County taxes are collected; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Bono, Arkansas, desiring to conform to the requirements of Arkansas Code Annotated 26-71-202, does hereby certify the rate of taxation to be as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONO,
ARKANSAS


SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby certify and state that the rate of taxation to be levied by the City of Bono, Arkansas is as follows:

1. City General – 2.0 mills on each dollar of the assessed value of real property.
2. City General – 2.0 mills on each dollar of the assessed value of personal property.

SECTION 2. That this certification should be delivered by the Mayor of the City of Bono, Arkansas on or before the time fixed by law for levying county taxes to the County Clerk of Craighead County, Arkansas, so that the County Clerk may place the amount so certified on the tax books of the County Clerk and collect said taxes in the manner that the state and county taxes are collected.
