

- 4 **Discounts**-Show rate, total amount, and latest day any discounts will be allowed after receipt of article and invoice, otherwise County will deduct allowed discount when payment is made.
- 5 **Firm Price**-All prices quoted will remain firm for at least 30 days from date of bid, unless otherwise specified by the County or bidder.
- 6 **Tax Exempt**-Craighead County is exempt from State sales tax on self propelled equipment and motor vehicles. Example: Motor graders, excavators, dozers, dump trucks, pickup trucks, etc.
- 7 **Identical Bids**-In the event of two or more identical low bids, the contract may be awarded arbitrarily or for any reason to any of such bidders, or split in any proportion between the said two or more bidders at discretion of the County.
- 8 **Clean up**-Complete cleanup and proper disposal of any and all job related items is considered to be a part of any contract let by Craighead County.


